### **Some things are meant to forget. Some are meant to remember!**

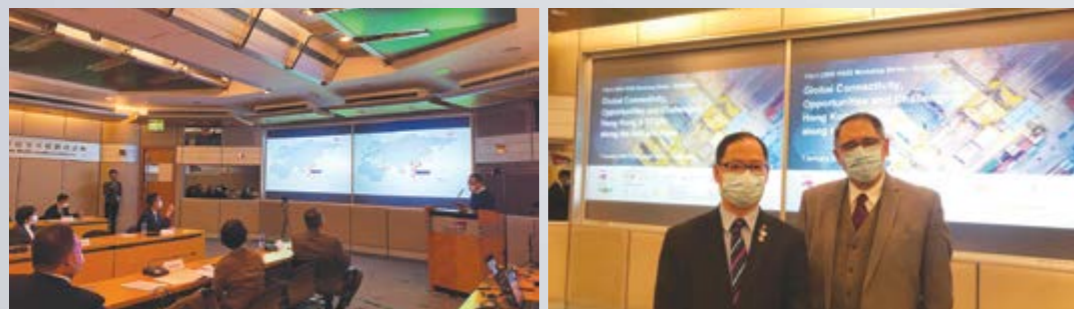
